**Vinification & Yield:** The grapes were whole cluster pressed and the juice was settled and racked off the lees into stainless steel tanks. There is a control of the temperature for the whole fermentation period.  
**Tasting Note:** Peach, apricot and notes of lemon-lime. Dry and medium-bodied, with notes of juicy stone fruits, a spritz of lemon and a mineral driven finish. Yield: 4 tons per acre.
